

The importance of a well-designed space for mental health.

Fun Fact: According to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Americans spend about 90% of their time indoors. Our surroundings play a crucial role in our mental, emotional, and physical health, and thoughtfully curated spaces can significantly enhance our quality of life. Our mission is to design homes that are not only beautiful but also nurturing for the soul.

Here are 2 ways of many we promote wellness to the families we serve:

- 1. We take away the huge financial burden of furnishing an entire home, generating an immediate focus on stability and themselves. Knowing that you have a place to call home can alleviate stress and anxiety, reducing the likelihood of depressive symptoms or suicidal thoughts. Long-established studies show strong associations between moving three or more times and increased behavioral and emotional problems, even when poverty does not complicate the picture.
- 2. We give them the bedroom of their dreams. Adequate rest and relaxation are essential for maintaining good mental health and reducing the risk of depression or other mental health issues.


